Fusion Center Project

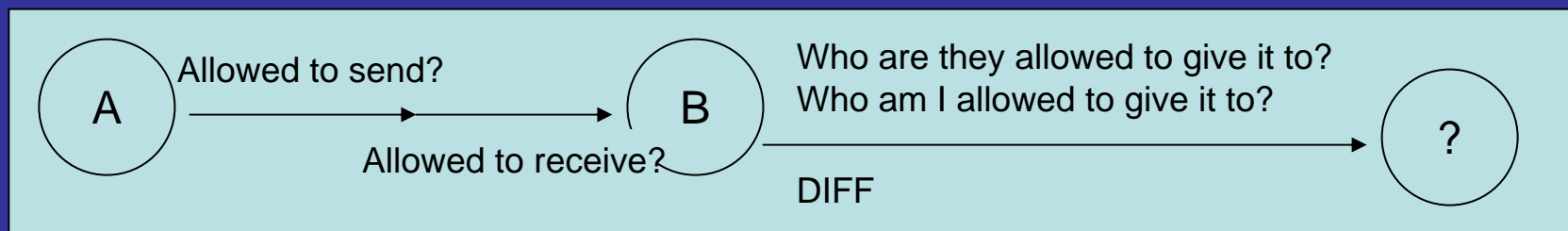
- Fusion Centers:
 - physical/virtual locations
 - for sharing information
 - from different organizations
 - with different policies

Focus: Attempts to send or receive a particular document from a particular person to a particular person or community.

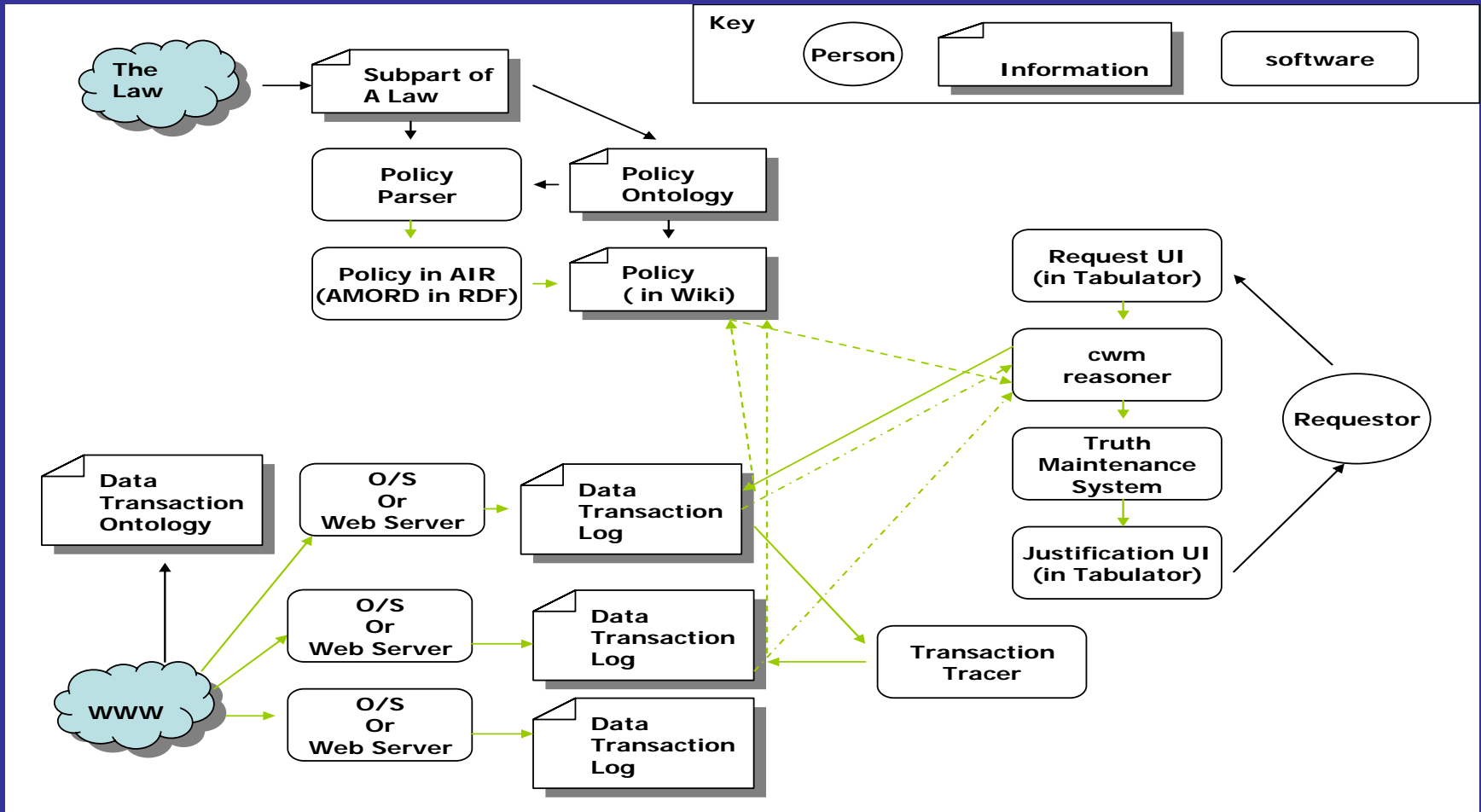


Possible Questions

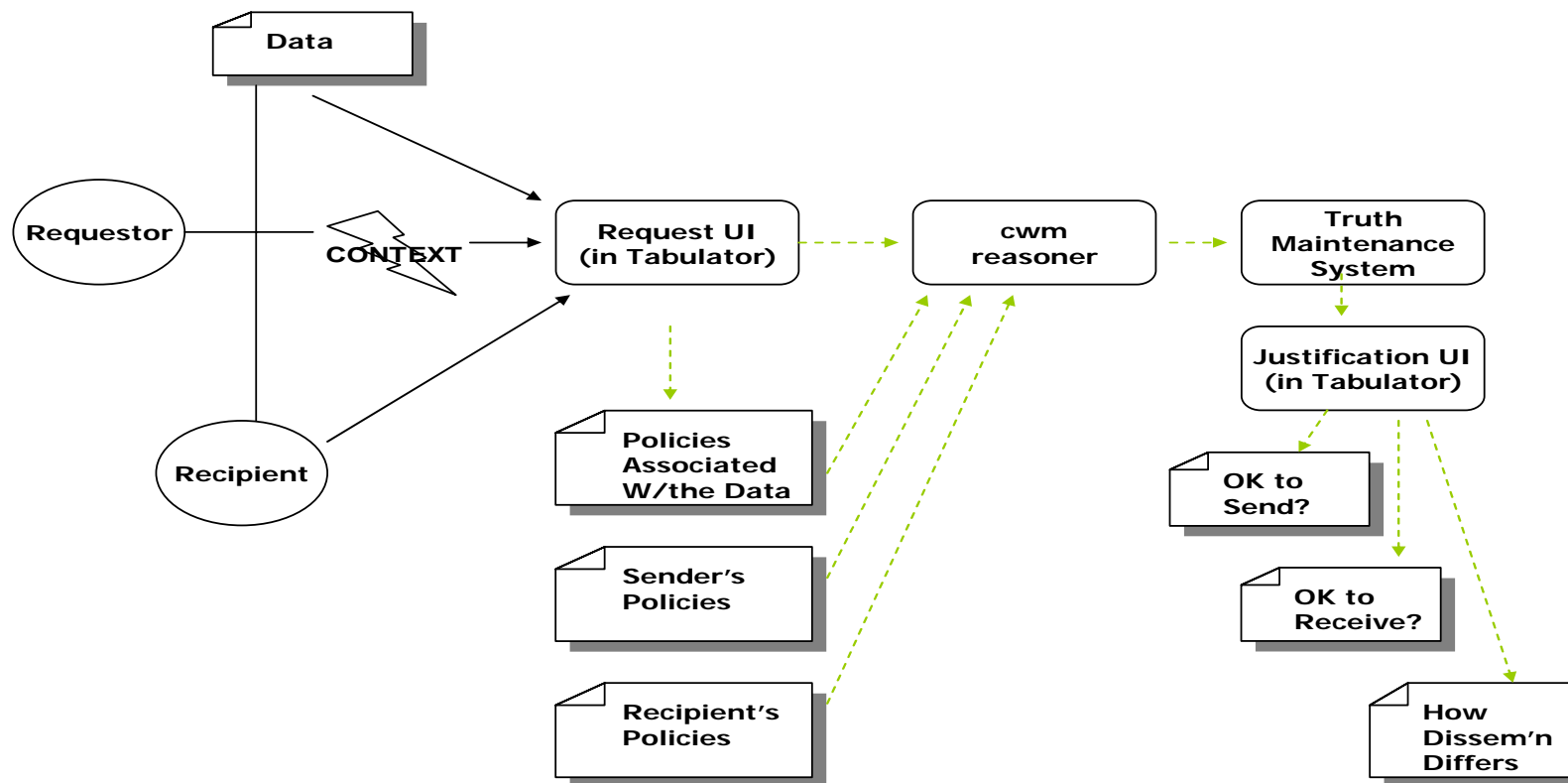
- Am I permitted to *give* this information?
 - What are rules regulate my organization?
 - What rules have traveled with the data?
- Is the proposed recipient allowed to *receive* it?
 - What rules regulate them?
- Do I *trust* them with the information?
 - What do their rules allow them to do?
 - How does that compare with what my rules would allow?



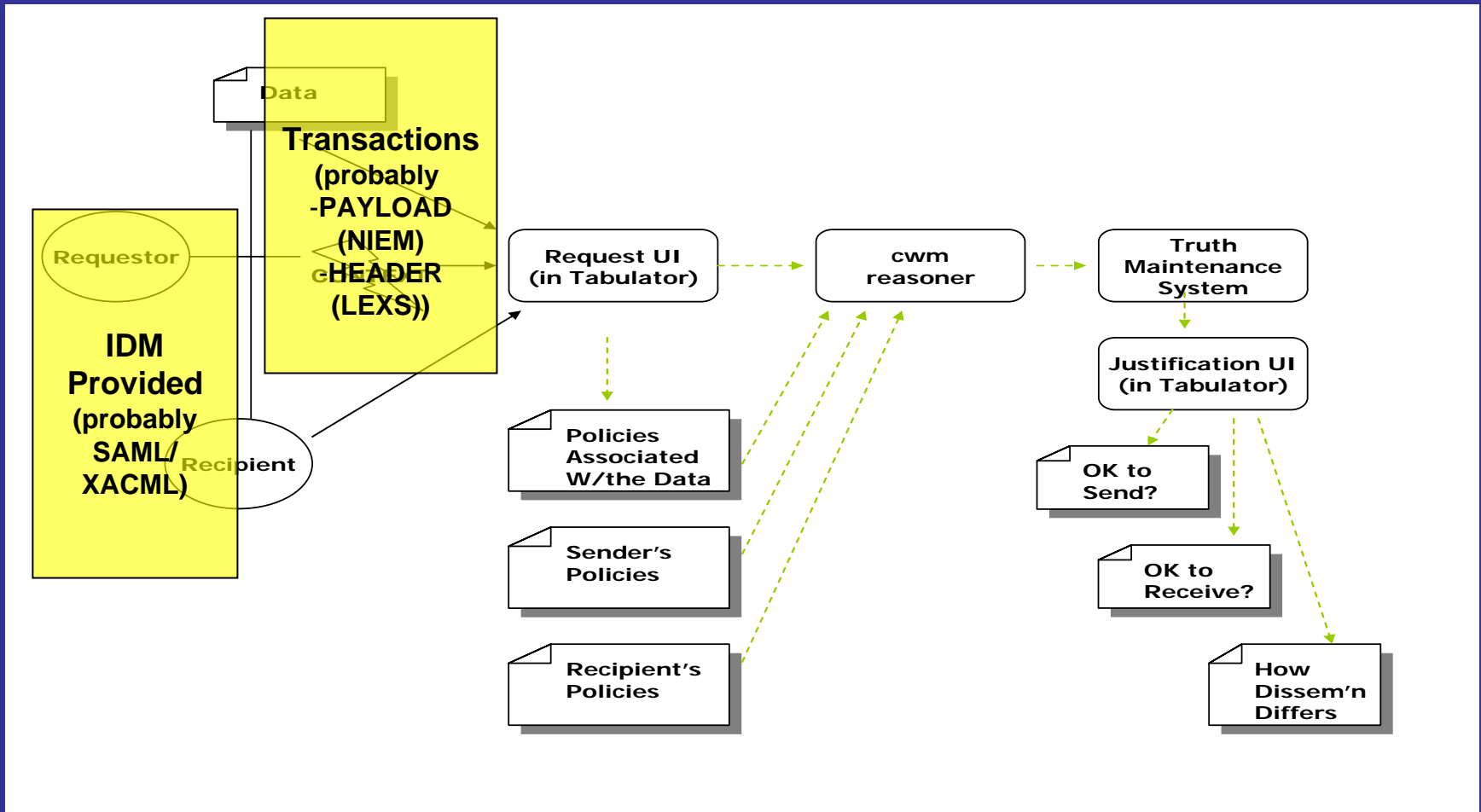
Past Project Concept

Projected Timeline

- Dec-Jan:
- Visit Fusion Centers
 - Learn business process for deciding when, how, and to whom to disseminate reports
 - Gather and understand the privacy rules
 - Gather UI requirements
 - Create scenario (including 6 transactions)
- Jan-Apr:
- Choose no more than 150 discrete sub-policies
 - Convert policies to intermediate semantic structure
 - Report on gaps in policies
 - Produce code in AIR
 - Report on challenges to code in AIR



Projected Timeline

- Jan-Apr: Create schemas for transactions
Create ontologies for transactions
- Feb-July: Incremental UI meetings
Enhance Justification UI
Demonstration of reasoning over each transaction
- July- Aug: Arrange visits to 10 government professionals
